## IMPORTANT ENTRY INFORMATION

### Registration/Entries:

- \$15 per entry, with a maximum of 3 entries.
- Your payment MUST be received for your entry to be accepted. The deadline for this is 4pm Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> September
- No couriered works please!
- **No alterations after entries close 22<sup>nd</sup> September.**

### Entry age:

This awards exhibition is open to artists 19 years and over at the time of entry. Please see **YOUTH FORM FOR UNDER 19YRS**

### Categories:

All works will automatically enter the “open section/competition”.

Works may be entered into **only one themed award** category.

If your entry also fits the criteria for an awards category, then you may also tick that relevant category one entry per category.

### Looking West & Our People Our Place:

Only artists living in West Auckland are eligible to enter these 2 categories.

### Commission:

Waitakere Arts commission on work sold is **30%** of the sale price (incl. GST). Personal tax liability is the responsibility of the artist.

### Insurance:

Is the responsibility of the artist. While all due reasonable care will be taken with your artwork, Waitakere Arts does not accept responsibility for loss or damage whilst work is in transit or being exhibited.

### Judging:

The judge's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into. All work will be judged. Any work that does not meet exhibition standard will not be hung.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

All work must be original and the sole work of the artist (thereby not subject to copyright infringement) and must NOT have been done in a class of instruction. All work entered must be signed by the artist. Direct copies of other artists' work or copies of copy-righted photographic images will not be accepted.

We will not accept wet, badly presented work and/or inappropriate content.

All mixed media work needs to adhere to all copyright laws and not exceed 40% usage of unoriginal printed material. (i.e. Must be your own work)

### Size:

Any hung work must not exceed 120cm or 3kgs, including the frame. Oversized or heavy work will not be accepted.

3D/Sculpture – if your work is heavy or fragile, please consult with the office prior to registration/submission of your entry.

**Label Identification:**

Please attach a swing tag to the back of your artwork's cord. The swing tag must include Artist's Name; Phone no; Title of Work; Category; & Price and medium used.

**All work *must* be ready to hang using D-rings and cord. If you're unsure of how to string your artwork, please watch the video at the following link ([https://youtu.be/O-TQdM\\_FNI](https://youtu.be/O-TQdM_FNI)) No staples showing on edges. Work must be of an exhibition standard.**

**Age of work:**

All work must have been completed between September 2023 and September 2024 and not have been previously exhibited anywhere else. All works must be for sale.

**Prize winners:**

You will only be contacted prior to the exhibition if you have won a prize, though we encourage all participants to support their fellow artists and attend the opening evening and awards ceremony.

**Exhibiting your work:**

Work entered for this exhibition must remain on display for the full duration of the exhibition and CANNOT be picked up by the artist before 4:30pm, Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> October.

**Collection/Pick up:**

Collection of work is the responsibility of the artist. You may collect your work from Shed 2, from 4:30pm - 7:30pm, Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> October or 10am – 1pm Monday 14<sup>th</sup> October.

NOTE: Failure to collect work will result in a \$20 per day fee to cover moving and storage of the artwork, unless it's an emergency and prior arrangements have been made with the Office Manager. Artwork will become the property of Waitākere Arts Council and be sold or donated to charity if not collected by December 1<sup>st</sup> 2024.

**Media:**

Waitākere Arts reserves the right to photograph and publish any entries in such media as they see fit, to promote these or subsequent art events, and will endeavour to take all necessary steps to protect your work from digital theft.
